

## TubularHerringbone by Ann Page

## **Supplies:**

11/0 Amethyst Color Seed Beads 15/0 Purple Seed Beads 8mm & 4mm Amethyst Beads Fireline -6lb Size #10 Beading Needle Scissors or Thread Zap Bead Mat Clasp

- After threading your needle, pick up
  4 Size 11/0 seed beads.
  \*\*\*I am using sizes 8/0 & 11/0 for this demonstration to make photographs easier.
- 2. Sew back through the size 11/0 seed beads in the same direction as before to make a circle.





3. Separate the circle into 2 stacks of 2 beads each.



- 4. Add 2 size 11/0 seed beads. Sew back through the 2 beads in the first stack to make a circle. Pull the thread snug and sew through the beads you just added again. This should make 3 stacks of 2 beads each.
- 5. Repeat this step to make a total of 4 stacks.



6. Sew through the first stack again to join the ends together. Go back down through the last stack again to secure it to the first.



- 7. Pick up 2 size 11/0 seed beads. Sew down through the top bead on the next stack going in a clockwise direction. You will exit that stack between the two beads.
- 8. Pick up a size 15/0 bead.
- 9. Go over to the next stack. Insert your needle between the two beads in that stack and sew up to the top so your size 15/0 bead is between the 2 stacks.
- 10. Repeat this at least 5 times to create 1 segment.



11. End the segment by coming out of the last size 11/0 in the stack. Pick up 1 size 15/0. Sew down into the 11/0 bead next to it, across to the 11/0 next to that, then back up that 11/0 and through the size 15/0 you started with.



12. Pick up a gemstone bead and a small size 15/0 bead.



13. Sew back down through the Amethyst bead & into the 15/0.



- 14. Sew back up through the amethyst bead. Add another 15/0 bead on top of the Amethyst. There should be 2 on top.
- 15. Sew down through the amethyst and into the 15/0 bead again.
- 16. Sew back up through the amethyst bead and come out of one of the small size 15/0 beads.



17. Make sure your needle & thread are coming through one of the small 15/0 beads on top.



18. Add 2 size 11/0 seed beads & sew back down the same size 15/0 bead.



19. Sew back up the size 15/0 bead next to the first.



20. Pick up 2 more size 11/0 beads and sew back down through the second small size 15/0 seed bead.



- 21. To continue the herringbone pattern, repeat the process starting with step 5.
- 22. Alternate adding larger (8mm) and smaller (4mm) Amethyst beads to your beaded rope.
- 23. Create the entire length of rope that you desire. The slide and tassel will fit over the beads.
