

ON THE FRINGE

EARRING TUTORIAL

NEED

- Flush cutter
- Ring mandrel
- Chain nose pliers
- Acculoop plier
- 16 g wire, 7.5" x 2
- 20 g wire, 2'
- Tassels or dangles
- 2 jumprings
- 2 earwires
- 2 focal beads

1



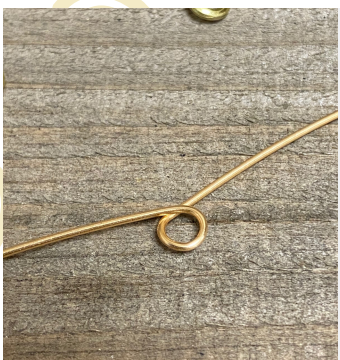
Use mandrel or dowel to shape each piece of 7.5" wire into overlapping horseshoes.

2



On 2mm mark of acculoop plier, roll each end into a circle. This will widen the horseshoe in the process.

3



Take 1' 20g wire and starting 1" from end, make 4mm loop.

Then, make 5mm loop, 6 mm loop, 7 mm loop, and back down again until you get to 4mm. Repeat.

5



Create 2mm perpendicular loop on either side of each piece you just created.

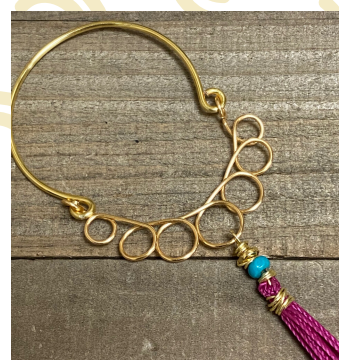
Attach tassels or dangles to middle of each piece.

7



Open perpendicular loops on each piece you just created.

8



Attach vertically to each horseshoe piece to create base earring pair.

9



Use excess wire to wrap focals and attach to top of horseshoe, leaving room for a jumpring.

Attach jumpring and earwire.

11



Add the rest of your tassels and get ready to feel cute!!!

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
